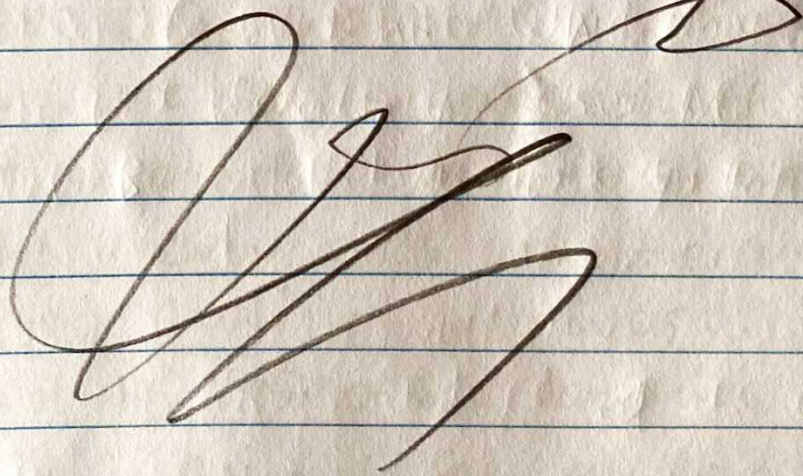
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Day 3

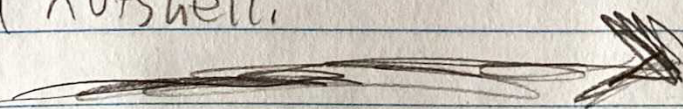
Day 4 7/25/2021
